## natural latex sealant

Natural latex – may cause allergic reaction



Separates (in bottle and in tire): must be shaken



Dries up in 1-6 months



Dries into balls of rubber – has to be stripped out



Goes solid when CO<sub>2</sub> inflators are used



Eats foam inserts, not recommended



Does not coat sidewalls well



Gives off ammonia, smells horrible, rots rims and tires



## milKit tubeless sealant

Synthetic latex - Allergy free

Always stays in solution: consistent, no need to shake

Stays liquid for 6-9 months

Dries into smooth layer – top up dose without problems

CO<sub>2</sub> friendly

Safe with inserts, recommended

Sticky formula clings to sidewalls without leaving rubbery layer

Ammonia-free, rim and tire friendly
