Cons

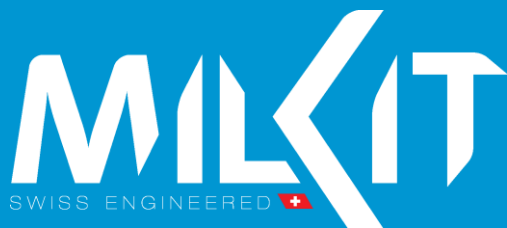

Pros

Most efficient on the market

11bar/160psi available right at the valve – no hose needed. This will help you pre-pop your TL tire on the rim in fractions of a second.

Cons

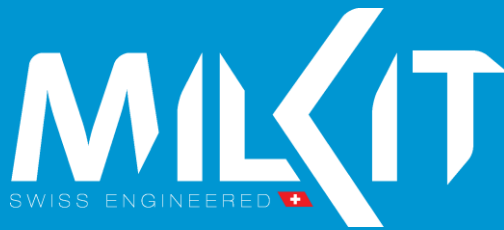
Mini pump compatibility

It takes long to inflate with a mini pump – however this is not very often the case

milKit tubeless sealant

Pros

Ready to use, no shaking required

Due to its formula the sealant always stays consistent, ready to perform. No more separated particles at the bottom of the bottle.

Longer life span

Stays consistent in tire, does not separate into rubbery leftovers and water and therefore performs significantly longer

CO2 compatible

6mm holes sealing ability

Because of the micro-fibers and particles the sealant is very effective, also in high pressure tires

No ammonia

No damage to rims, tires and inserts and no bad smell

Mess-free sealant

No balling of rubber, easy to remove from tires and clothes

Coats side walls better

Sticky formula clings to sidewalls and improves sealing function

Cons

Slightly more sealant needed

Due to its thicker solution, on first installation you need a little bit more sealant than your average sealant brand
